The historic 1880's saw Goulburn become one of the country's first regional centres to supply piped drinking water to its residents. This facility is the only complete operating steam powered municipal water pumping system left in the original location in the southern hemisphere. The 1883 Appleby Bros. beam engine and the 1860's Hick Hargraves corliss valve engine will be operating during the open day. The pumphouse cafe will be open. Tours available.
