### IMPASTO PAINTING WITH ACRYLICS

Wednesday 20 January 1-3pm

**MEDIA: ACRYLIC PAINT ON CANVAS**

**Suitable for 5-12 years, cost: \$33 /NT members \$30**

Impasto is a way of applying paint, specifically a thick, textured application of paint where the marks made by the brush or palette knife stay visible. Impasto is evident in the work of exhibiting artist Nicholas Harding. Children who enrol in this fun and interesting workshop will be able to take home their own unique impasto painting.

### STILL LIFE: TURNING 2D INTO 3D

Thursday 21 January 1-3pm

**MEDIA: DRAWING, MIXED MEDIA & PAPER CLAY**

**Suitable for 7-14 years, cost: \$33 /NT members \$30**

Using a still life as a starting point, this enjoyable workshop will guide students in how to turn a two dimensional sketch into a three dimensional scene. Children will respond to a still life choosing objects arranged on the table and using materials such as charcoal, pastels and air drying paper clay. Objective drawing and modeling with soft clay will allow children to interpret and express their creativity in a variety of ways.

### 3D PORTRAITS WITH CLAY

Friday 22 January, 1pm - 3 pm

**MEDIA: SCULPTURE - CLAY**

**Suitable for 5-12 years, cost: \$33 /NT members \$30**

This workshop is designed to encourage children's creativity and imagination by interpreting the human portrait using three dimensions. By utilising paper clay, children will hand build a portrait including the face neck and shoulders. This workshop will introduce children to sculpture as an art form, and each child will have the opportunity to create and take home their own unique ceramic piece. This workshop will incorporate clay hand building techniques such as kneading, cutting and coil construction.
